Old Business:

Decals/Glassware –we will not pursue getting extra sheets of 1 ½ inch decals, it's not worth the effort and the vendor did give us an excellent price on what we did receive. Dave Bossie made the motion to sell the sheets

at \$14.00 each. Steve Rannals second, motion passed. Mark Crain brought several glasses to look at, some already fired with the logo. He has graciously agreed to pick up various types for club purchase. At this time we will get pint glasses, stemware (tulips), small pilsner, 3 oz beakers, 1 liter pitchers and 1.5 liter pitchers. Preliminary costs are \$40/case of most items, approximately \$3 each for beakers. When final cost is determined, selling price will be discussed.
